

Custom Log Home on 5.3 Acres! Horse Property!



The scenery around Dubois, Wyoming is like nothing else on Earth. From the painted badlands to majestic Absaroka & Wind River Mountains, the Dubois area has it all. The Wind River, a blue-ribbon trout stream, runs through the town and high mountains lakes are filled with trout. The entrances to Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks are located only 50 miles away.

This one of a kind 3,000 s/f custom hand-crafted log home on 5.3 acres is made of huge lodgepole pine logs. The logs are of full scribe construction. Full-Scribe log joinery is the oldest form of log home construction. Its techniques are centuries old and have remained virtually unchanged. Full-Scribe building techniques require many years of apprenticeship before one can truly master its intricacies. Full-Scribe is also known as the "chinkless" method. The logs are naturally shaped and smoothly peeled that are scribed and custom-fitted to one another. This log home is the Cadillac of log homes and is located in the scenic Upper Little Warm Springs Creek Subdivision just outside Dubois' town limits.

The California flagstone woodburning fireplace is the centerpiece of the home's open floor plan. The fireplace's interior is solid block masonry. Fans & vents are built into the fireplace to add even more warmth on cold winter evenings. There are beautiful cathedral ceilings that reach 22 ft. from the floor to the upper level. The main heating for the home, however, isn't the expansive fireplace. The home has a large furnace, which can use gas, coal or wood. The furnace is forced hot air and heats the entire home efficiently.

The large kitchen boasts solid hickory cabinets and a large island with a granite countertop. Lovely tile backsplashes accent the kitchen walls. The kitchen has ceramic tiled floors as well as the home's entryway.

The dining area is nestled just off the kitchen where there are wonderful views of the Wind River Mtns. through the French doors. Sometimes furry friends look through those doors into the dining area! Moose & deer are frequent guests – and elk herds and bighorn sheep are commonly seen from the home.



The home's main level bedroom has beautiful log & aspen walls. There are special ordered knotty pine doors throughout the home and every closet in the home is cedar lined. Just outside the main level bedroom is a large bath.



The expansive master bedroom is located on the upper level. The room features log & aspen walls, a walk-in closet, a large master bath with a cedar lined jetted tub, and a private balcony in which to enjoy views of the Wind River Mountains. The master bedroom also boasts a propane "woodstove".

Upstairs, one also finds a cozy loft, perfect for an office space or sleeping alcove and a cat walk that looks down into the Living area and Dining room below.



There is 1,500 s/f of covered wrap-around redwood decks so one can enjoy the views in any direction.



The home's lower level is currently in the process of being completed into a family/media room, an extra bedroom as well as a fully equipped kitchen and another full bath. A 1 car garage is also located on the lower level.



Also on the property is a unique RV/barn. The RV section of the barn holds a full sized RV. The other part of the barn is made for horses in mind. There is a large horse stall that can easily be turned into 2 stalls. There is also a nice paddock area for your horses to kick up their heels. Ride you horse or ATV directly from this property onto miles of national forest roads to your heart's content. There is so much more to this lovely home and property! Definitely a must see!
